RE: CEP RESPONSE TO PROPOSED CHANGES TO REGULATION 6.12

At its final meeting of AY 2011-12 (June 5, 2012), CEP reviewed additions to R6.12 proposed by the Committee on Rules and Jurisdiction. I apologize for the delay of my memorandum on this matter.

CEP supports the intent of this proposal and only expressed concerns about potential ambiguities in the proposed language of R6.12.1. Members of the committee were particularly concerned with how the proposed rule distributed the delay of changes. The committee wanted to be certain that the policy applied to changes in curricula and requirements for both courses and majors, proposing language such as this:

“R6.12.1 Changes in a curriculum or prerequisite requirements both for courses and majors may not be implemented until the quarter following the publication of the change in the General Catalog unless an exception is approved at the time the change in curriculum or prerequisite requirements is adopted. “
