Re: Proposed Revision to APM Sections – 133, 210, 220, and 760

At its meeting on June 12, 2014, the Committee on Faculty Welfare considered, but has no comments to offer if the numerous editorial and organizational changes found in APM section 133-17-g-j, Limitation to Total Period of Service with Certain Academic Titles, and APM section 220-18-b, Professor Series.

The Committee discussed the proposed revisions to APM section 210-1-c &d, Review and Appraisal committees. While the committee agrees with the policy's intent to encourage contributions to diversity, it does not see how the policy can be uniformly applied across all academic disciplines.

The Committee discussed the proposed revisions to APM section 760-30, Family Accommodations for Childbearing and Childrearing. While the committee agrees with the changes, it feels the language lacks specific detail as to what constitutes stopping the clock.
