RE: Student Proposal for Gender Studies Breadth Requirement

The CHASS Executive Committee discussed the Student Proposal for Gender Studies Breadth Requirement at the regular meeting on November 19, 2014. The committee endorses the proposal with the friendly caveat that the course listings be revised by a small committee of faculty with expertise in gender/sexuality studies, representing several departments. Gender/sexuality should be a major component of the course, and identified as such in the catalog description for the course. The number of courses that would likely be edited from the list accompanying the proposal is small. The Executive Committee feels this slight revision will only strengthen the proposal, and will review an edited list of CHASS courses at our January meeting.
