The Committee on Rules and Jurisdiction considered the proposed bylaw change for the Senate Committee on Diversity and Equal Opportunity and finds the words “continuous surveillance” in 8.6.3 A not to be consistent with or conducive to the preamble of APM 015 (faculty code of conduct) which states the following:

"The University seeks to provide and sustain an environment conducive to sharing, extending, and critically examining knowledge and values, and to furthering the search for wisdom."

By a vote of +0-3-0, the Committee on Rules and jurisdiction does not support the proposed change and further recommends eliminating duty A and incorporating the preexisting phrase “at its discretion, makes recommendations for improvement in specific practices and general policy” within the body of duty D.
