

**Subject:** CNAS Regulation Change regarding Banner


Executive Council reviewed the proposals to modify CNAS regulations 2.4.5 and 3.4.3. Council does not support the changes proposed as they are motivated solely by the limitations of the recently adopted Banner system.

Furthermore, it is Council's position that any future proposals that follow from the Banner adoption should be accompanied by evidence that a technical solution was considered, and with a critical evaluation by Computing & Communications of the feasibility of such a technical solution. An evaluation of the impact on students and programs should also be provided.

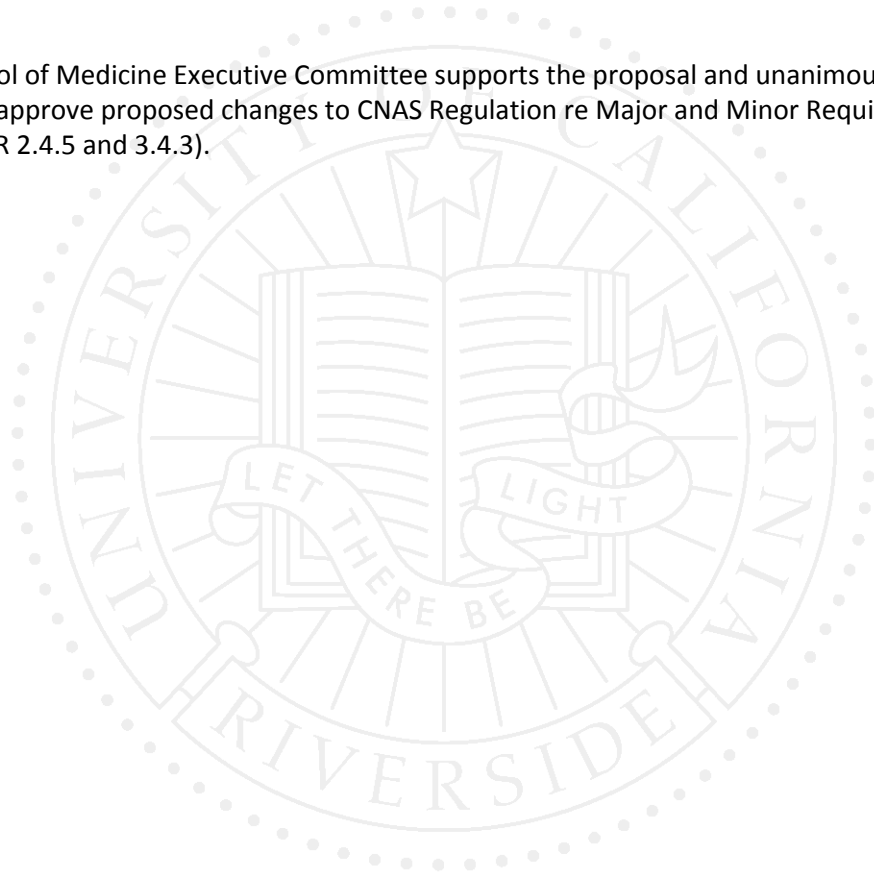
