**RE:** Request for Exception to 1/6 Limitation on Appointment to Professor of Clinical X Series

The School of Medicine Executive Committee supports the proposal by Interim Dean Neal Schiller and unanimously voted to approve the request for an exception to APM 275-16-f (3), which states that the Professor of Clinical X series should not exceed 1/6 of all local Senate members in all clinical departments on the campus. As our new school of medicine is growing we require more flexibility to recruit and appoint clinical faculty with strong academic training and leadership in the Professor of Clinical X series without being constrained by the 1/6 ratio rule.
