Re: Change Review of Change Management Workgroup's Recommendations for Banner

The Committee on Courses reviewed the Change Management Workgroup's Recommendations for Banner at their October 1, 2015 meeting and again at their December 3, 2015 meeting. In between the two meetings, Registrar Bracken Daily was consulted regarding concerns with the recommendations.

The Committee is supportive of the following recommendations:

- 16 Unit Repeated Unit Maximum
- Terminology- Concentration/Track/Emphasis
- Individual and Group Activities
- All or None Pre-Requisite Checking; Registrar Input
- Running of Academic Standing after the Summer Term

The Committee noted concern with the recommendation to change the deadlines and timing of the add/drop period, lapse for non-payment, and start of "W" grading for withdrawals. The Committee questioned how changing the deadline to the second week would solve the problem with issuing withdrawals. In addition, the Committee opined that they were not sure how the recommendation would affect financial aid for students. The Committee was supportive of the other elements of the recommendation.
