

The Committee on Planning and Budget reviewed the request to establish the S. Sue Johnson Presidential Endowed Chair in the School of Medicine at their October 31st meeting. Planning and Budget was in support of the proposal and the MOU but would like the School to complete the form (Request to Establish a Named Endowed Chair) correctly. The form needs to include the academic justification and resources that will be needed. The current text speaks broadly to the SoM but does not address the justification for this Endowed Chair specifically. The committee believes this endowed chair will support the burgeoning growth of Neuroscience on the campus but this needs to be specified. The Resources paragraph should explicitly mention the matching funds from the UC Presidential Endowed Chair program.
