GSOE Selected
Highlights:

- During this academic year, the GSOE made three new hires, one at the Assistant Professor level and two at the Full Professor level; all were part of cluster hires. The new faculty are: Professor Tara Yosso, Professor David Stovall (to begin, 2018) and Assistant Professor Kinnari Atit (to begin, 2018).
- Keith Widaman served as GSOE Associate Dean, Graduate Students. Scott Brooks was GSOE Associate Dean for the Undergraduate Major; upon his leaving UCR his duties and responsibilities were transferred to Louis Rodriguez who took over as Associate Dean, UG education. Eddie Comeaux was Graduate Advisor for incoming students; Rollanda O'Connor was Graduate Advisor for enrolled students.
- The GSOE worked toward consolidating area groups, resulting in the creation of Learning and Behavioral Sciences (LABS), comprised of faculty in Special Education, Educational Psychology, and School Psychology.
- The GSOE developed an undergraduate major in Education; the motion supporting this was approved by the Academic Senate.
- The new UG Education major is to be marketed as “Education, Society, & Human Development.”
- The GSOE developed a new M.Ed. program in Applied Behavior Analysis; students will begin enrollment in Fall, 2018.
- During the 2016-17 we launched a new MA, the Research Evaluation & Measurement Program.
- A task force was appointed to explore the feasibility and relevance of offering the Ed.D. degree in the GSOE.
- Throughout the 2016-17 academic year, staff from the GSOE were invited to make presentations to the faculty to increase faculty awareness of staff roles, to facilitate knowledge of GSOE functions and to increase collaboration among faculty and staff. Topics were selected by faculty and presentations were made at most faculty meetings.
- During 2016-17, the GSOE increased the number of Information Sessions for potential graduate school applications; faculty involvement in these sessions also increased. In addition, the GSOE promoted graduate programs (e.g., M.Ed. in Higher Education) to staff at UCR.
- Faculty participated in a survey on service assignments conducted by the Executive Committee for the purposes of determining workload equity.
- Graduate students in the GSOE had the opportunity to complete the Graduate Climate Survey. The purpose was to obtain student feedback on the overall graduate experience that the GSOE could use to guide subsequent program changes.
