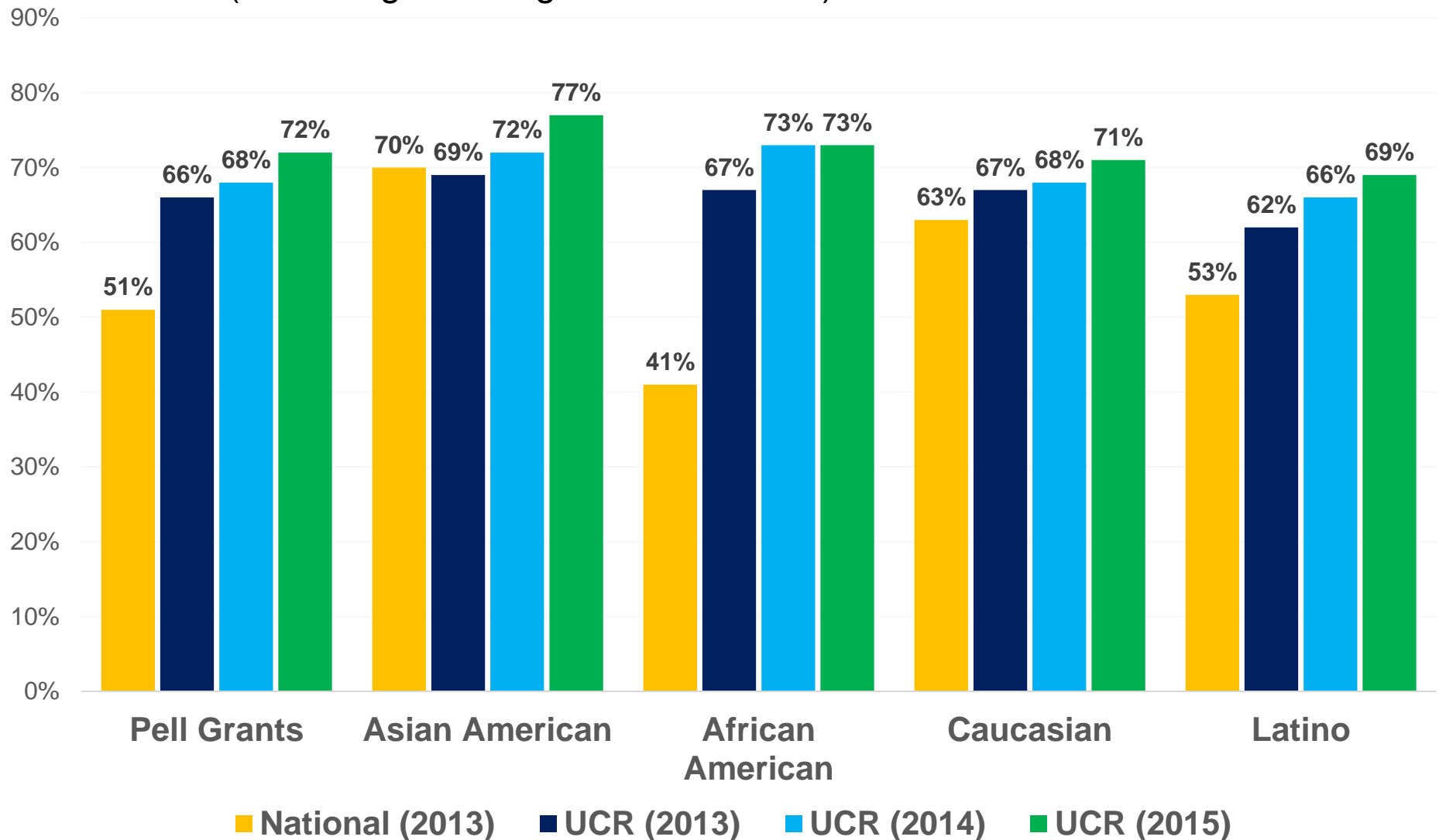
# Student, staff, faculty growth: 2000 to present

# Enrollment update

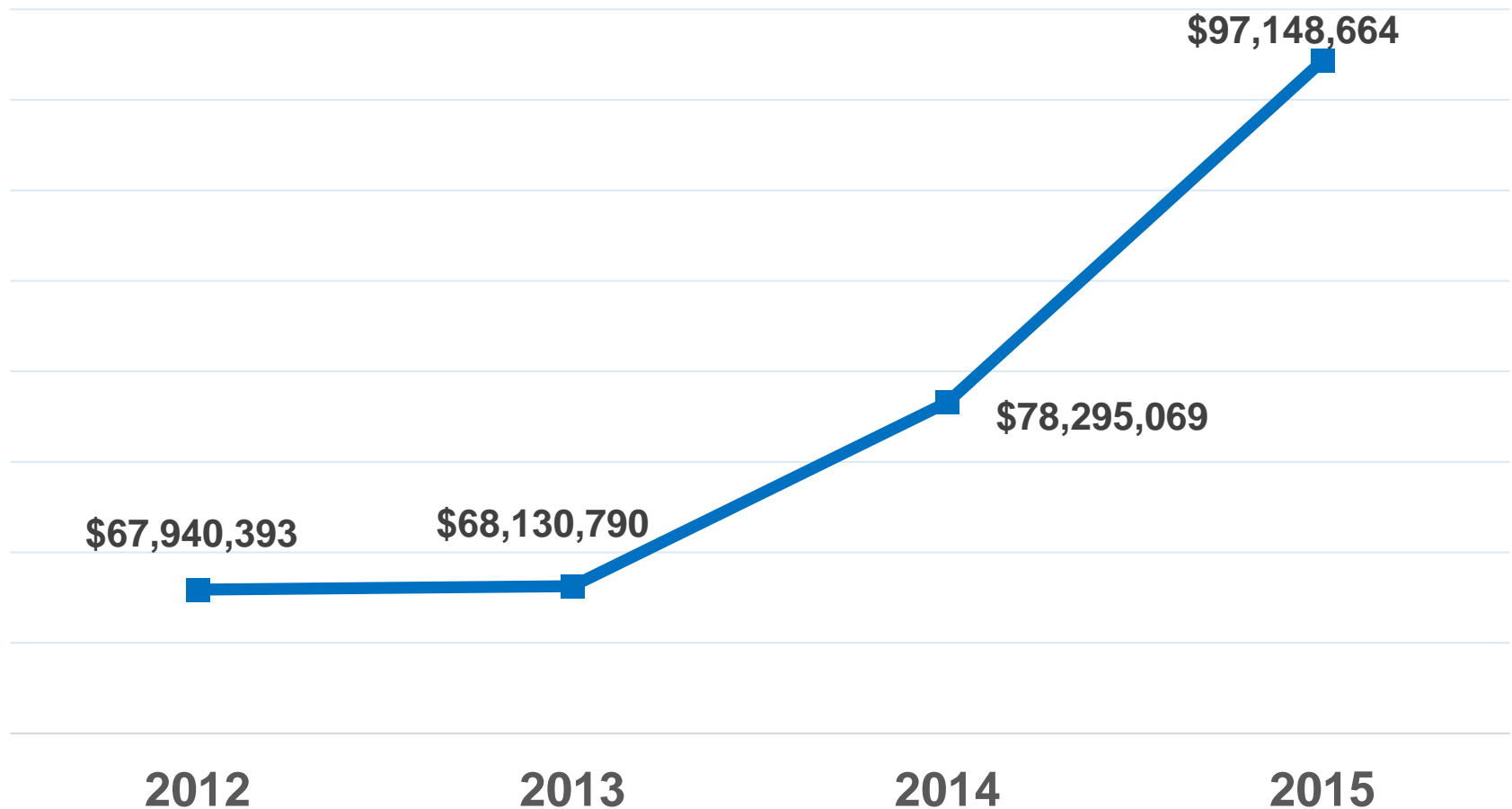
- ▶ 52,467 undergraduate applications for Fall 2016
  - ▶ Up 10.1% from 2015 (up 20% from 2014)
  
- ▶ 977 additional CA resident students this fall
  - ▶ 19% increase from Fall 2015

## UCR six-year graduation rates compared to national averages (Cohorts graduating in 2013 to 2015)



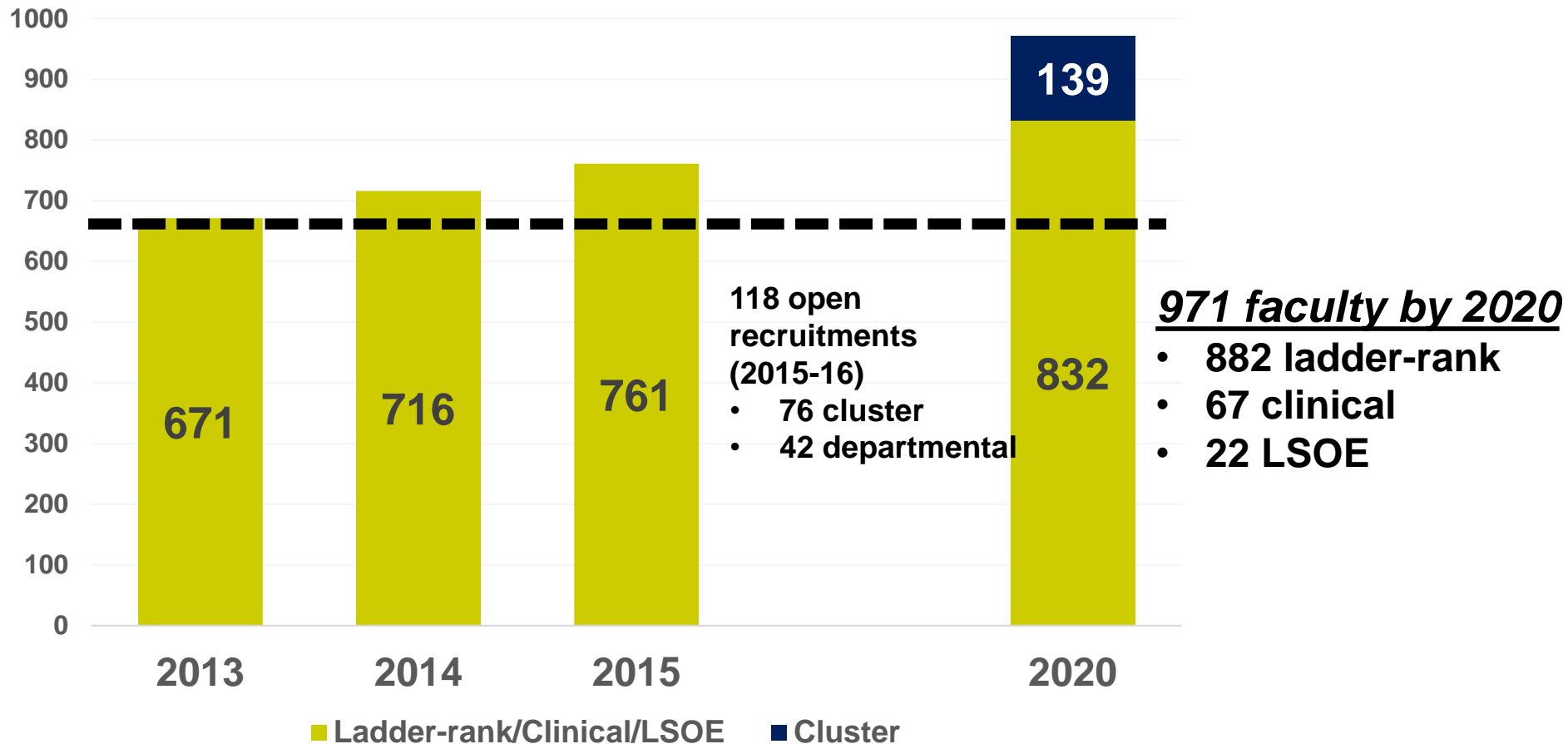
# Growth in research funding

# Faculty Hiring Program: Process

- › April 2014: Announced goal of expanding Senate faculty by 300 over five years
- › April to October 2014: Discussions on feasibility and budgeting
- › October 2014: Decision made to pursue cluster hire initiative as part of faculty hiring plan
- › December 8, 2014: RFP announced
- › March 20, 2015, Proposals due
  - › 128 proposals submitted by faculty
- › March to May 2015 Review of proposals by Deans Council and faculty panel (including Senate representation)
- › May 2015: 33 clusters announced
- › Creation of faculty steering committee
  - › Committee formed from nominees by each college/school dean
- › Search committees formed
  - › Reviewed/approved by steering committee members from the relevant colleges/schools
  - › Required to engage with department faculty when developing short lists, interviewing candidates, and developing final recommendations.
- › **Current status: 118 senate faculty positions open**
  - › **76 cluster (all ladder-rank) & 42 departmental (35 ladder-rank)**
