The primary function of the Committee on Charges is to receive in writing, through the Chancellor or Chancellor's designee, unresolved complaints regarding Faculty conduct, as per procedures described in SBL336 and UCR Division Appendix 5. The Committee may also be asked to opine on proposed revisions to Bylaws and Regulations which may be related to the charge of the committee.

The Committee on Charges completed its review of eight cases and forwarded its decision to the Chancellor.

In addition to review of faculty conduct cases, the Committee on Charges is also asked on occasion to comment on System-wide and Campus Policies. To that end, the 17-18 Committee on Charges commented on the Human Resources policy on Consensual Intimate Sexual or Romantic Relationships in the Workplace and the Proposed Revised UC Policy on Sexual Violence and Sexual Harassment.
