

**Committee on International Education
Annual Report to the Riverside Division
December 4, 2018**

The International Education Committee of the Academic Senate met three times during the 2017-2018 academic year.

The Riverside Division of the International Education Committee was represented on the Universitywide Committee on International Education (UCIE) by Covadonga Lamar-Prieto who is the Chair of the Riverside Committee. The Committee was updated by the Chair at each meeting as to the issues being discussed at the Systemwide level. The major topics included the new UCOP 30% international initiative, UCR's new transfer ratio initiative, and the increase of international student fees.

Additional, discussion was had regarding DACA and how it would impact students at UCR. The committee requested a presentation from the Director of Undocumented Students Program to get more information. The committee also requested that the Chair of International Education be added to Executive Council's standing membership. The request is currently being assessed by Executive Council.

The Committee received updates from the Office of International Affairs at each meeting that detailed the Office's initiative and ongoing programs. Additionally, the Director of Undocumented Students Program, Ana Coria, and Graduate Division Dean, Shaun Bowler, attended the Committee's April 3, 2018 meeting to discuss various problems and programs the departments are pursuing.
