2017-2018 GSOE Selected Highlights:

- During this academic year, the GSOE made two new hires for Assistant Professors of Teaching: Dr. Cathy Lussier, who is most closely affiliated with our Educational Psychology program and Dr. Lorena Gutierrez, a former GSOE postdoctoral fellow, who will serve as the Assistant Director for the newly formed Center for Educational Transformation.
- Additionally, two new faculty were hired in our Learning and Behavioral Sciences area group: Professor and Pelayo Endowed Chair in Learning Disabilities, Dr. Asha Jitendra, and Assistant Professor of School Psychology, Dr. Wesley Sims.
- With the retirement of former Associate Dean in the summer, Keith Widaman, his former role was split into two roles: Dr. Jan Blacher will serve as the Associate Dean for Academic Personnel and Dr. Eddie Comeaux's former role as Graduate Advisor will transition to an Associate Dean of Graduate Students. This will build in more specific areas of support for each respective population.
- Dr. Louie Rodriguez was appointed to the Bank of America Chair in Educational Leadership, Policy, and Practice.
- We launched a new undergraduate degree program in education: *Education, Society, and Human Development*. We received 900 applications for 100 spaces for the first official year of this program; we accepted **108 new freshmen and 23 transfer** students for a total of 131 new students for fall 2018.
- Dr. Celeste Pilegard was nominated to replace Dr. Cathleen Geraghty on the GSOE Executive Committee, as Geraghty's two-year term ended.
- With Dr. Jan Blacher moving to the position of Associate Dean, Dr. Margaret A. Nash became the Faculty Chair of the GSOE Executive Committee for 2018-2019.
- In Spring 2018, faculty met to discuss issues surrounding the need for identifying practices to retain faculty of color. The GSOE created a new Faculty Welfare Committee as a place to address some of these issues. Dr. Jan Blacher and Dr. Margaret A. Nash were nominated to co-chair the new committee in its first year.
