The Committee on Distinguished Teaching is soliciting nominations for the 2021 Distinguished Teaching Award. Competitive nominees must be members of the Academic Senate and should have a track record of sustained excellence in teaching as part of a balanced career trajectory typically spanning at least 10 years. Nominees must receive ***three*** or more nominating letters from students and/or faculty to be considered for this award by **December 14, 2020**. Each nominator should submit directly to the Committee on Distinguished Teaching, Academic Senate Office a complete letter which must include at least the following information:

- (1) a statement explaining the nominee's qualifications
- (2) nominator's name and address.

Upon receipt of ***three*** letters of nomination, the Committee on Distinguished Teaching will request all available pertinent material from heads of departments and programs to be submitted by *February 5, 2021*. If the nominators wish to suggest additional sources of supportive materials, they are encouraged to do so.

Nominees of previous years will require re-nomination to be considered by this year's committee. Previous awardees are not eligible.
